#### SAMARITAN'S SHOEBOX APPEAL

As usual, we are taking part in the Shoebox Campaign for the **Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child Appeal** and you have already received the leaflet which tells you all you need to know about what kinds of things to fill your shoebox with and how to pack and wrap it. (There are spare leaflets in school if you need another.)

# Keep Universal Infant Free School Meals in schools in England

In September 2014 the government introduced UIFSM in schools in England. There have recently been a number of reports in the media that the government are considering scrapping UIFSM to save money. There is a petition online calling on the government to back UIFSM and not scrap it. At 100,000 signatures, this petition will be considered for debate in Parliament.
