#### Uniform

Uniform order forms were due in on 17 June. Mrs Kelly has now placed all the orders and so if you have not handed a form in, you will have to wait until September. **NO** jewellery will be allowed at all including earrings; the only exception to this is that children will be allowed to wear a watch.

#### **School Dinners**

School meals remain at £2 per day (£10.00 week). The Government scheme for KS1 children to receive a free school meal (that's Reception Class up to Year 2) is continuing in September.

Nursery meals will also remain at £2.00 in September. Your child's weekly lunches must be ordered and paid for on your child's <u>first</u> day of attendance. School meals are available to children attending nursery for a full day only. Please note that you can provide your child with a packed lunch as long as it adheres to our Packed Lunch Policy.

# News from the Local Authority E-Safety



Kik Messenger has become a popular app with some groups of pupils; however, we have been warned by Durham Police that it is being used by offenders to groom children to obtain indecent photos and videos. Please be aware that:-

- Kik has a minimum age of 13, and it is not suitable for younger children due to risks associated with inappropriate and/or illegal sharing of images and videos
- Parents should manage their children's use of technology. Please set tablets and phones so that children
  cannot download apps without parental permission. (We have come across many cases where children have
  been abused through an app that parents and carers did not realise had been installed)
- If your child is old enough to use the app, and is mature enough to manage its appropriate use, please check
  the privacy settings so that your child's whereabouts and images are not being broadcast around the net
  without their knowledge.


#### **Induction Week**

Induction week at Wolsingham School begins **Tuesday 5 July** and will last 3 days until **Thursday 7 July**. The children will all move up into their new classes and Y6 children enrolling into Wolsingham School and Community College will be going there. Parents of these children will have received a full information pack from Wolsingham. Y6 children going to Parkside school will have a one-day induction only on Thursday 7 July and Consett Academy will also have a one-day induction on Thursday 30 June. Our children will remain in their new classes until Friday 15 July.

# News from the Local Authority Home to School Transport - Secondary

Pupils currently in Y6 who are due to transfer to Secondary School in September 2016 will be entitled to free home to school transport if they reside more than 3 miles from their nearest suitable school. In addition, for children who are entitled to free school meals or whose parents receive their maximum level of Working Tax Credit, under national extended transport rights, free transport will be provided to:

• One of the three nearest qualifying schools, if that school is more than two but less than six miles from the home address; or



Parents can apply online and access the Council's home to school transport policy at: www.durham.gov.uk/schooltransport

Pupils who are not entitled to free travel from Durham County Council can apply for a concessionary (spare) seat on school buses and taxis. There will usually be a charge which may be paid in instalments. At present this is £1.50 per day, but some schools have special schemes with different charges. Details of the scheme, including bus routes and how to apply, are available at www.durham.gov.uk/concessionaryspareseats or from the Transport Helpline on 03000 264 444.
















# And Finally .....
