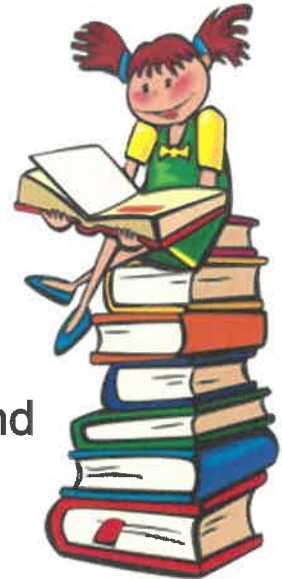
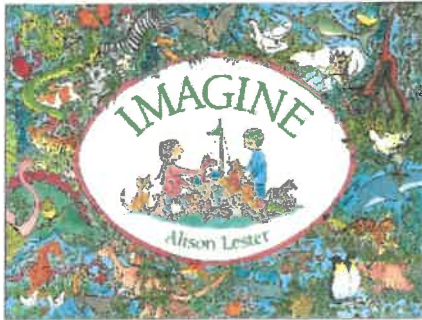

World Book Day

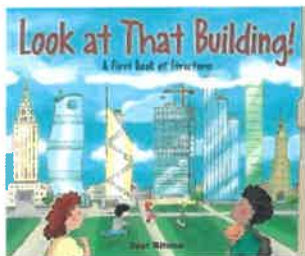
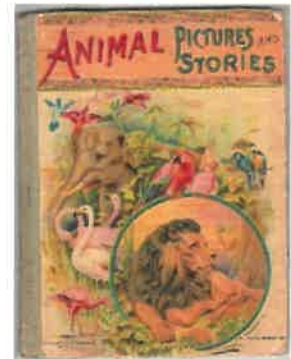


Dear Parents and Carers



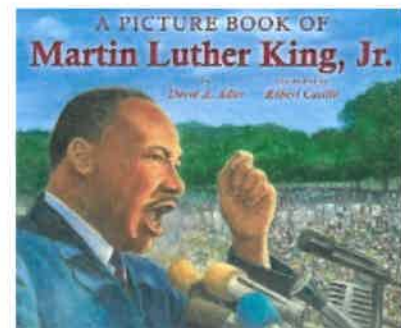
As you know, we value reading in our school and would like to thank you for your ongoing support for our spring term reading reward competition.
