School Dinners

School meal prices will remain the same next year, ie £2.05 per day. From September, however, we will be moving to using ParentPay to pay for school meals. Lots of you will be familiar with this and already have accounts for older siblings. We hope that this will be an efficient way to manage dinner monies and ask you to work with us to establish this during the summer term ready for full use in September.

As far as we are aware, the Government is continuing the Universal Infant Free School Meal scheme and so this will be continuing for KS1 children to receive a free school meal (that's Reception Class up to Year 2).

School meals are provided to children attending Nursery for a full day only. Please note that you can provide your child with a packed lunch as long as it adheres to our Packed Lunch Policy.

ParentPay is also a communication system and will replace ParentMail. You will therefore need to register with the new system and instructions will be sent out at a later date.

If you would like to donate any cakes/buns, please bring these in the day before or on the morning of the sale.


Reception Graduation
