Nursery

Our Nursery will continue to be offered from 10am-1pm. We will be unable to offer 30 hours provision in autumn 2nd half term 2020. We will continue to use joint working practice with our local childminders to ensure our 30 hours nursery pupils receive the education provision they are entitled to. This will be revised in December in time to plan for January 2021.

Transition sessions will be completed via Microsoft Teams in the last week of half term:

Reception - Miss Marr will read the new Year 1 children a book to introduce herself.

Year 2s - Miss Dobson and the Year 3 children will answer questions from the children.

Year 4s - Miss Mawson and the Year 5 children will answer questions from the children.

Please note - despite the school day being shorter for all pupils by 20 minutes, our lunchtime will be 20 minutes shorter due to lunches being eaten in classrooms. This means no child is missing a minute of their education due to staggered start/finish times.

We will allow some discretion for drop off/pick up times for parents who have children in a number of bubbles. We ask that parents who are experiencing difficulties with varied drop offs/pick-ups ring the school office to discuss flexibility with Mrs Jackson. However, we are treating the Nursery as totally separate and siblings in older year groups will attend at their allocated times.

Uniform

We will be enforcing our uniform policy from autumn 2nd half term, with the exception of shoes. Pupils need to wear trainers/appropriate footwear all the time as we will not be getting changed for PE and will be doing outdoor activities where suitable. Trousers/leggings will need to be worn on class PE days to allow us to do physical activities safely. We will add PE days to our Facebook page/the website. Our policy regarding jewellery remains the same, only an inexpensive watch is allowed.

Curriculum

In the second half of the Autumn Term our curriculum focus will be on literacy, numeracy, science, PE, RE, French (for KS2), computing, history and geography alongside PSHE and wellbeing. PE lessons will be taken outdoors. Assemblies will be held within 'class bubbles' in classrooms, or via TEAMS weekly to allow the whole school community to come together.

After school clubs

Each class will run one class club during the second half of the autumn term- further details of these will be shared after half term.

Homework

Whilst we will not be setting formal weekly tasks we would ask that you continue to read daily with your child/children and, as appropriate, practice the following: times tables and/or phonics.

Buddies/School Council/Green Leader/Young Carers meetings

We will carry out elections for 2020 - 2021 at the end of autumn 1st half term and you will be informed by email if your child has a specific role for 2020 - 2021.

For Years 1-6 there will 1 School Councillor, Buddy and Green Leader per year group. Reception will have a Buddy. The roles will be different this academic year, the children won't attend weekly meetings but will have a role within their class bubble.

School lunches

Taylor Shaw will continue to provide a hot meal to all children. After half term, this will be a three-week menu and any child can bring in a packed lunch for a day when they don't like the meal on offer. We will share the menu on our Facebook page/the school website. The children will continue to eat at their desk to minimise cross contamination and cleaning.

Remote learning (local lockdowns)

From autumn 2nd half term, legislation from the government comes into place that school will provide remote education and pupils will complete online remote learning tasks if they are self-isolating.

Halloween Activities

Each class bubble will have an afternoon of fun Halloween activities on the last Friday of term - 23rd October. Everything needed for this afternoon will be provided by school.
