During the academic year 2024-2025, Governors and leaders at Tow Law Millennium Primary School worked hard to improve accessibility. They have:

- Improved identification signage
- Continued to improve the perimeter fence by adding a barrier of hedging to increase security.
- Increased provision of sensory areas/safe spaces in all areas of school.
- Improved the outdoor play for all children in EYFS/KS1.
- Replaced/repaired all lifting flooring.
- Update fob door release system classes 3 and 4

All work is agreed by the Governing Body and overseen by the Health and Safety Governor, Mr. S. Hall, and an Action Plan drawn up merging the priorities for the coming 3 years with the priorities from our DfE building conditions survey. Some planned works, based on our original conditions survey, on further investigation were now considered not compliant so therefore changes were no longer needed.

Our immediate priorities for 2025-2026 are:

- Replace internal kitchen door to porch with one with a vision panel.
- Replace internal kitchen door to store cupboard with one with a vision panel.
- Security fencing to 3 sides of the school
