- **Class 4:** Miss White (Miss Mawson - EYFS Lead)

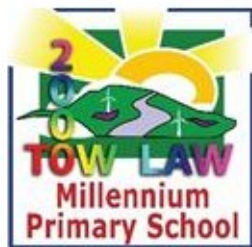
