

BEST VALUE STATEMENT 2026



The Governors of Tow Law Millennium Primary School are committed to achieving Best Value in all decisions made. We use the principles of Best Value as they apply to securing continuous improvement in this school, and will:

- regularly review the functions of the school, **challenging** how and why services are provided and setting targets and performance indicators for improvement;
- monitor outcomes and **compare** performance with similar schools and within the school;
- **consult** appropriate stakeholders before major decisions are made; and
- promote fair **competition** through quotations and tenders to ensure that goods and services are secured in the most economic, efficient and effective way.

We will strive to ensure that the school is using its resources effectively to meet the needs of pupils.

We will submit our Best Value statement with the annual budget plan. The progress of the annual budget plan and the Best Value statement will be monitored with the School Improvement Plan in order to determine the extent of continuous improvement.

The school has in place a strategy and a set of guidelines, (update annually), which will ensure that Best Value will be reviewed and demonstrated. This year we will focus on the following:

- Prioritising wellbeing of pupils and continued focus on mental health.
- Creating a KS1 sensory area.
- Raise standards in Reading of pupils with SEND through Super Sounds
- Improve attendance of targeted pupils – specifically persistent absentees.
- To apply for funding bids to develop our outdoor areas to support SEMH and gross motor.
